### **Welcome**

Welcome to The Rolling Barrage VIII – Route Information Guide – 2024. The Route Information Guide is in Version 5.0 for June 29, 2024. Likely there will be changes that will require further updates. As we have done in the past few months, we will continue to post updates on The Rolling Barrage website, create a blog that provides general information on the changes, and then post it on our Facebook page.

The end goal is to provide you, the rider, with the most up-to-date and critical information as soon as possible whether you are doing the Full Pull or riding with us for 1 day.

### **Route and Registration**

The Routes provided are based on the maximum information provided to all riders and participants when the information was published.

Updates to the information contained within the document is subject to change such as dinner arrangements for example.

Timings while on the move are based upon best estimates. However, factors such as tourist traffic, newly started construction, or an accident or emergency-based situation may alter timings.

Any changes before the commencement of The Rolling Barrage VIII – 2024 will be published on our website and notification via our Blogs and Facebook page. The documents are dated and have the Version Number.

## Route Sheets

The following pages are the Route Sheets which in turn is part of the entire Route Information Guide. The Route Sheets start in Newfoundland and end in British Columbia.

The information contained within the Route Sheets is as accurate as possible. Factors that can affect timings for example are **construction projects** that can start after the publishing of route sheets. This can affect travel times and potential traffic patterns.

**Weather** is and can be unpredictable. This can also influence timings within the route sheets. Depending on the weather type an effort to ride through it to get out of the weather conditions is an option based on safety first and foremost. In some cases, due to safety-related issues, the ride has to delay.

**Natural disasters** or areas currently under Emergency Management control by local municipalities or provincial authorities can also impact everything from routes to timings. When feasible we will endeavor to communicate the situation as quickly as possible on our Facebook page minimally.

**Accidents** can occur at any time. In the past, there have been unfortunate accidents that have taken place that the ride encounters. Depending on the severity of the accident it can delay the ride. This may be due to the route being a highway with limiting by-pass options or authorities, and first responders, closing the road until the matter has been investigated and the roadway re-opened. When feasible we will communicate the situation as quickly as possible. However, the safety of the active ride, riders, and participants is paramount.
